

**APRIL 25 TILLEY CLASSIC FOR 410 SPRINT CARS & SUPER LATE MODELS
NEXT ON SELINGSGROVE SPEEDWAY'S 75th ANNIVERSARY SCHEDULE!**

SELINGSGROVE, Pa. – Selingsgrove Speedway will honor the memory of the track's all-time career leading sprint car feature winner with the running of the Icon Legacy Custom Modular Homes Ray Tilley Classic for the Lelands.com 410 sprint cars at 6 p.m. Sunday, April 25.

Joining the 410 sprint cars on the special Sunday night racing card will be the Jeff's Auto Body & Recycling Center super late models. Track gates will open at 4 p.m.

The 30-lap Tilley tribute race will pay \$5,088 to win and \$400 to start out of a total purse of \$19,888. Time trials, heat races, and a B-main will be the qualifying format. The April 25 race will be the first of the season for the Lelands.com 410 sprint cars.

The super late models will compete in a 25-lap race paying \$3,000 to win and \$300 to start. Gregg Satterlee of Rochester Mills scored the late model season opener at the track on April 10.

For fans who cannot attend the race, the event can be purchased as a live streaming broadcast on sprintcarunlimited.tv.

The late Ray Tilley of Pine Grove clinched four career sprint car titles (1965-66 and 1968-69) at Selingsgrove Speedway at the wheel of the Bud Grimm Special No. 88 and remains on top of the track's all-time sprint car win list with 69 career victories. Tilley passed away on Aug. 9, 2011, from complications of a stroke at the age of 77.

The Tilley Classics in 2012, 2014, and 2019 were cancelled due to weather. Last year's race fell victim to the COVID-19 pandemic shutdown. The 2013 race was won by Brent Marks of Myerstown. Greg Hodnett of Thomasville was the 2015 winner and Danny Dietrich of Gettysburg scored the victory in the 2016 race. Lucas Wolfe of Mechanicsburg was the winner in 2017, with Mark Smith of Sunbury taking the checkers in 2018.

The Lucas Oil American Sprint Car Series (ASCS) will return to Selingsgrove Speedway at 6 p.m. Saturday, May 1, in the RiteWay Sealing & Paving "Battle of the Groves" for the 360 sprint cars. The 25-lap main event will pay \$4,000 to win. The limited late models and roadrunners will also be on the May 1 card.
